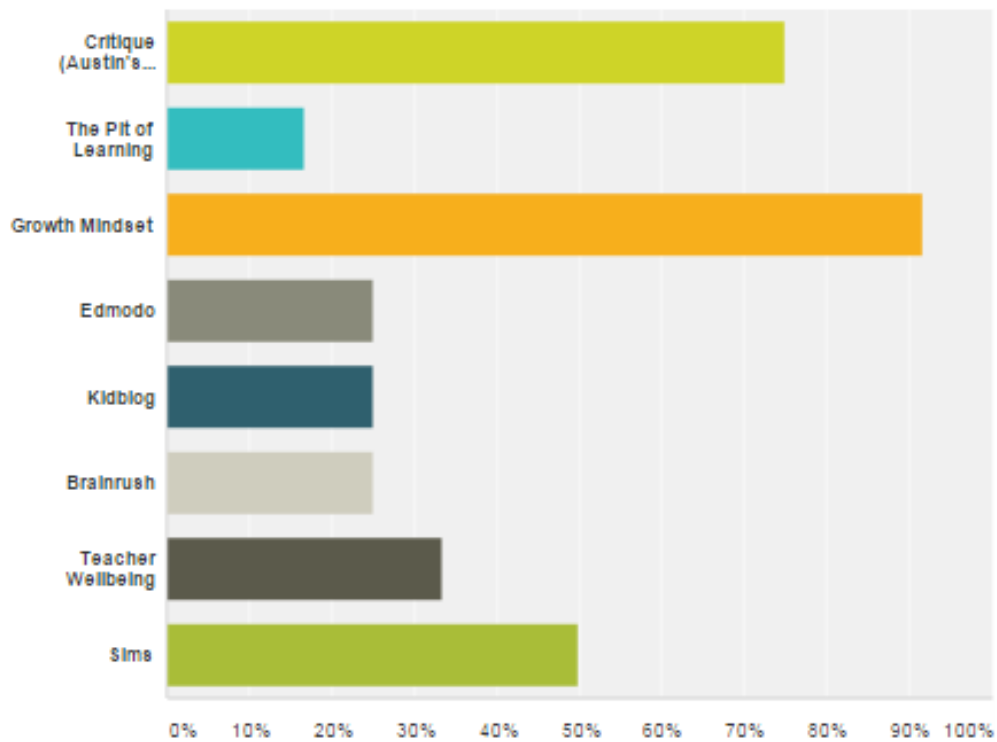

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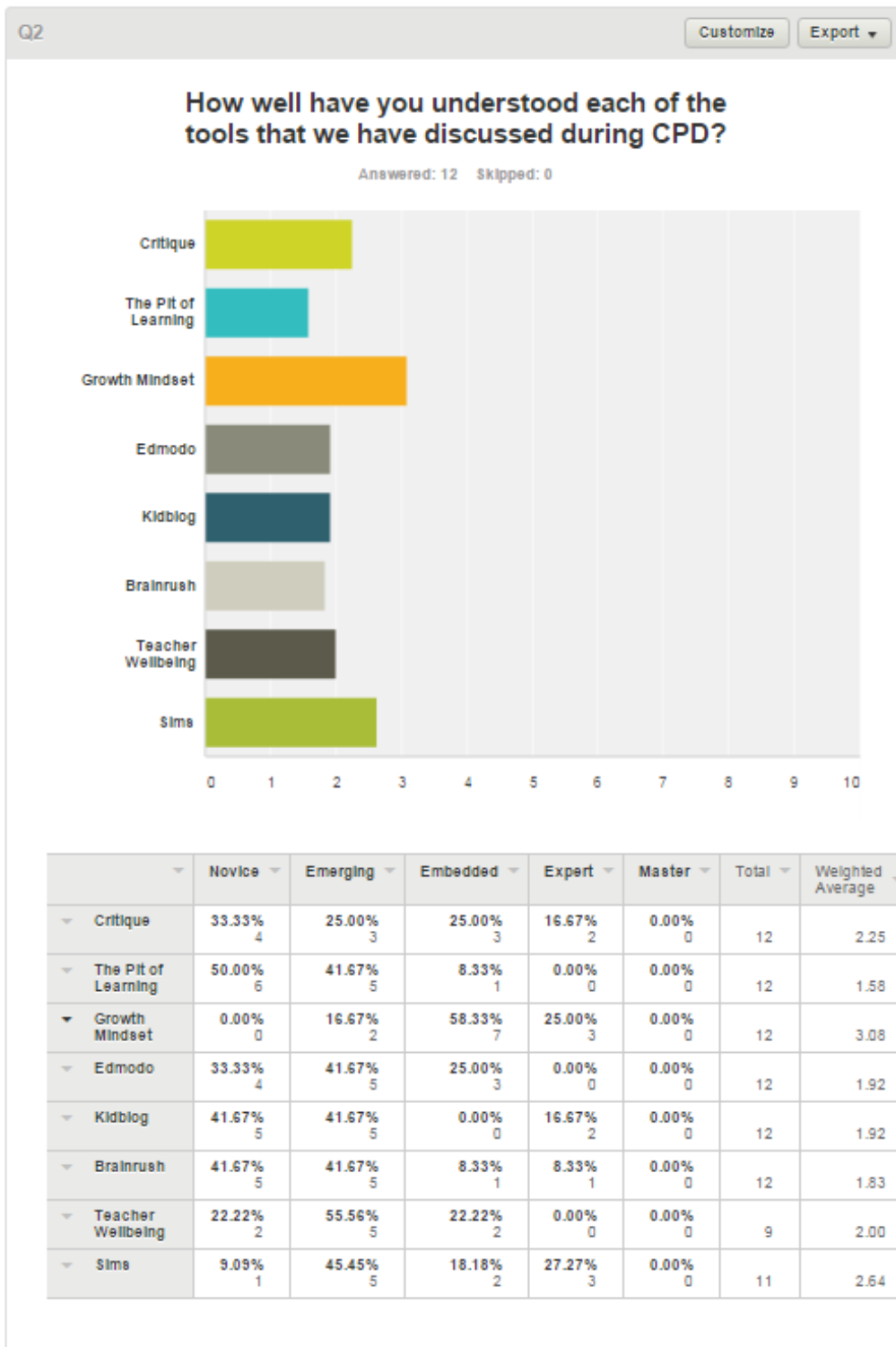
Which of the tools that we have discussed during CPD do you think you will use in your future practice?

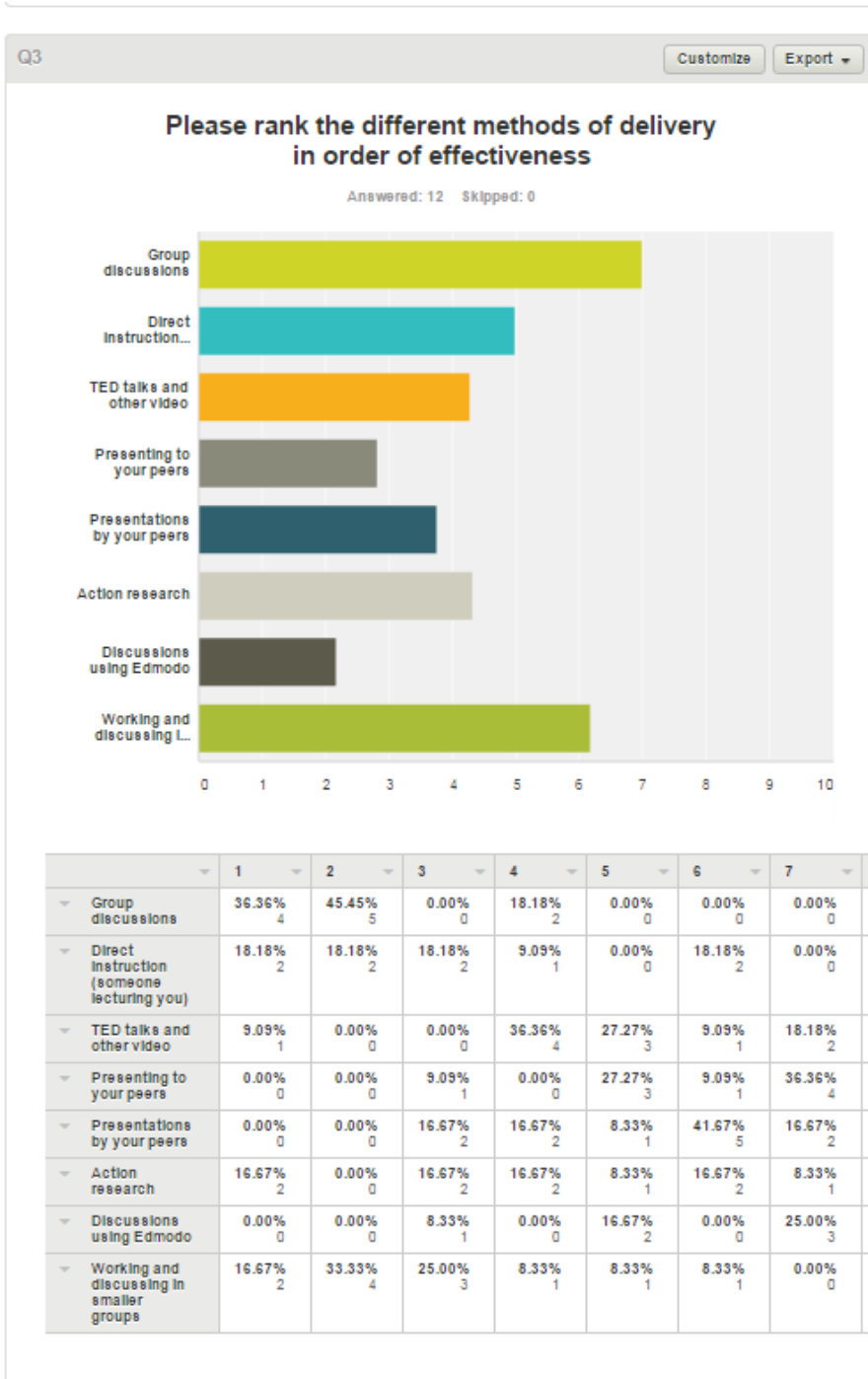
