Dear Parent/Carer,

Further to the Summer newsletter, I am writing to make you aware that homework support can be accessed via the Learning Hub every Tuesday and Thursday from 3.10pm-4.00pm.

The Learning Hub is based in SC4 which provides access to computers, and in the Library if resources are required there. Two members of teaching staff will be available each evening to provide guidance and support, along with Clancy Stephens our Hardy Centre manager and Ruth Ward our librarian. The long term aim of this provision is not solely to provide access to resources and guidance but is more focused on developing independent and positive homework and coursework practices.

The Learning Hub is available to all pupils on a voluntary basis, and pupils are welcome to simply turn up. If parents/carers feel they need support in encouraging their child to attend please contact your child's Head of Learning who will assist in this process.

Please be aware that should pupils be identified by their Head of Learning as having issues with completing homework on time and to the required standard across a range of subjects, you will be contacted. In this situation pupils will be required to attend the Learning Hub for six weeks (on both evenings) in order to embed positive homework habits that support their future learning.

If your child is having difficulties regarding homework or coursework in a particular subject, please contact their teacher directly.
