Year 10 Provision

Dear Parents / Carers,

Further to my letter dated 21st May I am writing to update you with our ongoing planning for some form of face-to-face provision with Year 10, before the end of the academic year.

I am sure the majority of you will have seen the Government has decided to move any opening of schools for Year 10 back until June 15th, at the earliest. We will therefore be planning for a provision to commence from 15th June at GTS, subject to being able to put the necessary measures in place.

We are in the process of creating a plan to facilitate a modified curriculum / timetable, which will allow us to address some of the gaps in knowledge this enforced closure has caused.

I cannot provide the exact details at this stage, but I can advise you we will be following Government and DfE guidance where we will only have 25% of the cohort in school at any one time. I will write to you again within a week outlining how the provision will be structured, the safety measures we will be applying and the expectations of pupils and their families. At this point, I will be asking you to decide if you will be sending your child to school based on the information you have received.

For the time being please continue to support and encourage your children to do their best with the remote learning currently provided.
