Virtual Open Events - Last chance, Tuesday 19th Jan

Applications for 2021 entry have been open for a while. Although Exeter College doesn't have an application deadline, we strongly encourage students to apply around this time of year as this will usually mean an earlier interview. Interviews will be taking place virtually through Microsoft Teams and students will be notified of their appointment date and time by email. (They can click on the link found in the email to join the meeting). If your young person applied before Christmas and haven't heard regarding an interview yet please don't worry. Our admissions team are amending our processes and will begin scheduling again soon. They should receive notification of their interview date within the next few weeks. If students do not have internet access, a telephone interview can be requested. Interviews will be taking place regularly until the summer holidays, however, we encourage students to apply sooner than this.
