Generic Job Description

The Science Ambassador role at Great Torrington School is of great importance. They will be students who are positive role models within science, the school and local community, and a link to our local Primary Schools. They will assist in all aspects of Science at GTS, local primary schools and within the local community. As such they are expected to:

- 1. Provide a role model to which students can aspire. Be approachable, providing support and guidance to students/potential students, thereby fostering a sense of community within the school.
- 2. Meet high standards of politeness, courtesy, dress, attendance and punctuality
- 3. Be ambassadors for Science attending Open Evenings and other events, and, as required visiting local Primary Schools
- 4. Attend meetings with staff as appropriate. Support specific members of staff or teams of staff (for example the staff organising The Big Bang Fair)
- 5. Take an active part in all Science activities
- 6. Promote GTS Science throughout the school community

The qualities of a Science Ambassador include:

- Earning and gaining the respect of pupils and staff
- Giving of their time and energy to support other pupils and the school
